### COVID-19 Safety Policy and Procedure for GOCA Students

#### 1. General Information:

- Any student that is coming on campus is highly encouraged to wear a mask while in school.
- Parents may opt-out by filling out a form through FOCUS account.
- Masks will be **required** during transitions in the hallways for the next 60 days ( Subject to change ). Opt-out requests will remain in effect and will be honored during this temporary requirement.
- Parents will be notified with instructions via email if their child has been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for Covid.
- If a class has a confirmed positive Covid case, temperature checks will be implemented for 1 week in the classroom.
- Parents are encouraged to report any illnesses/positive cases to the school right away.
- Frequent hand washing with soap and water – 20 seconds or longer will be encouraged for all students.
- Students are required to stay home if they are sick.
- If a student becomes ill while in school, parents will be notified right away. Students will need to be picked up within 1 hour.
- If a student has been out sick, they are required to provide a doctor's note prior to returning back on campus.
- If a student becomes ill, tests positive for Covid or has been exposed, parents will need to notify the school by filling out the following form:

- Ongoing sanitation and disinfection will take place in all common areas and offices such as Break rooms, office spaces, handrails, classrooms, restrooms etc.
- Hand sanitizers will be available throughout the school in common areas.
- If 20% of school 's staff and students are affected by Covid-19 quarantines the school may make a decision to close the campus. Any campus closure will be promptly reported to the school board of directors and an emergency board meeting will be called to address the situation.

- If more than 3 students are found to be Covid-19 positive in the same classroom, the class will be placed on quarantine. Parents will be notified with instructions via email.

### **2. Student that is Symptomatic or Covid-19 positive: If a student is experiencing any symptoms or has received a positive test result they should not attend school, school sponsored activities, or be on school property until:**

- The student receives a negative covid-19 test result and is asymptomatic or
- Ten days have passed since the onset of symptoms or positive test result, the student has had no fever for 24 hours and the student's other symptoms are improving; or
- The student receives written permission to return to school from a medical provider.

### **3. Students with Exposure to Covid-19: Students who are known to have been in direct contact with an individual who received a positive test result for Covid-19 should:**

- Parents will be notified with instructions via email if their child has been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for Covid. Your child will not be required to quarantine.
- Parents are strongly encouraged to schedule a COVID test for their child.
- Parents have an option to quarantine their child.
- If a parent wishes to quarantine their child, they will need to communicate directly with the school nurse and the child's teacher. Nurse may be contacted through email at [zmako@gocacademy.com](mailto:zmako@gocacademy.com)
- Students that chose to quarantine will be excused and will be required to complete work through google classroom or request a packet from the child's teacher.
- The parents and students that chose not to quarantine will be monitored closely and will receive daily temperature checks for 1 week.
- The school will continue to monitor all the cases.

### **4. Students with prior Covid-19 infection: A student who has received a positive Covid-19 in the previous 90 days and who is known to have been in direct contact with an infected person is not subject to the protocols set forth, as the student remains asymptomatic. If a student with a previous Covid-19 infection becomes symptomatic, the student should follow the procedures set forth in section 2.**
